are just busy with our day to day responsibilities, need to take a moment and breathe.

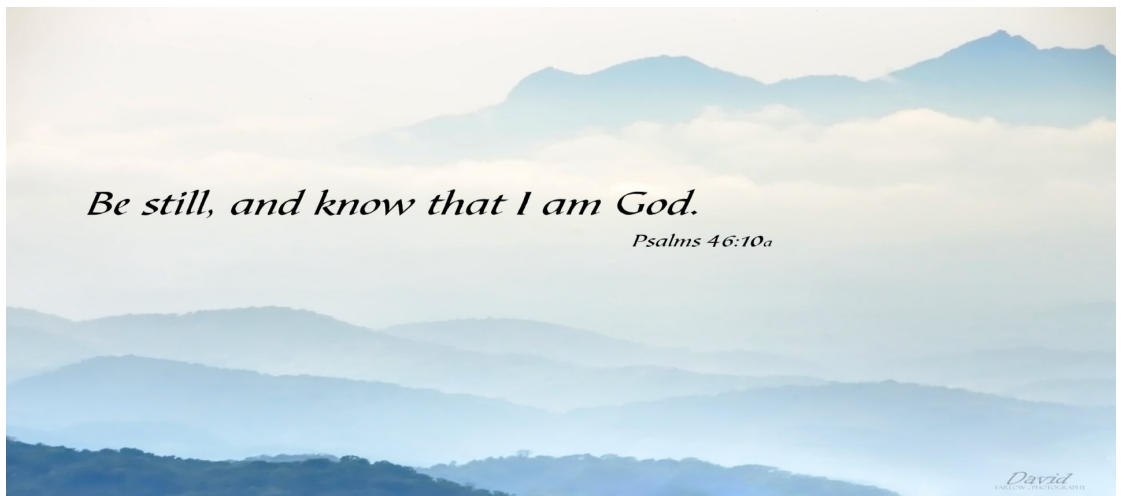

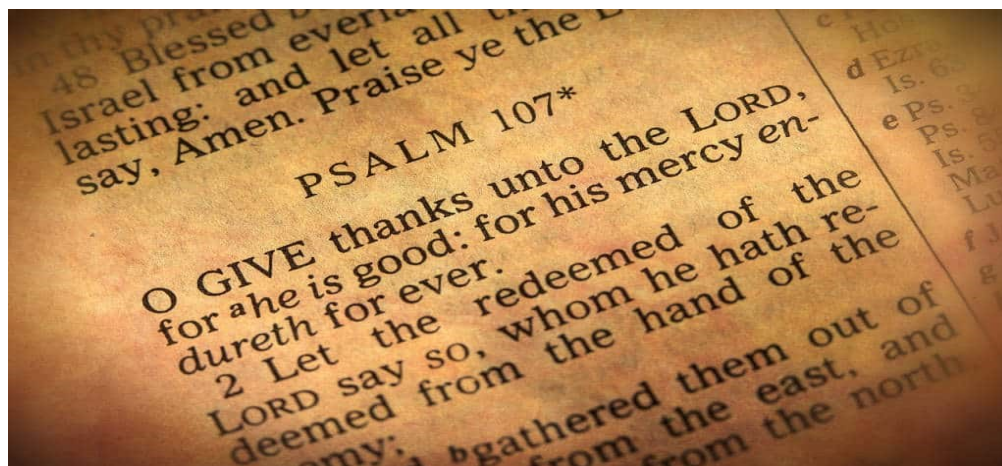
